

**CITY OF PLATTE  
CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
REGULAR MEETING (Second Meeting of the Evening)  
July 6, 2009**

**City Council President Joel Foxley called the meeting to order at Platte City Hall at 8:44 p.m.**

**Those present for Roll Call were: Arnold Dalldorf, Joel Foxley, Rich Hoppe, Gary Iedema, and Todd Spoelstra.** Rick Gustad and Jerry Overweg were absent. Others present were: Steve Christensen, Kevin Kuiper, Ralph Nachtigal, and Nicole Westerhuis.

**AGENDA.** The following changes were made to the agenda: ADD Executive Session – Personnel Matters.

**SWEARING IN OF NEW COUNCILMEMBERS.** Westerhuis administered the Oath of Office to Councilpersons Gary Iedema, Rich Hoppe, and Todd Spoelstra.

**ELECTION OF COUNCIL PRESIDENT/VICE PRESIDENT.** President Foxley declared that the floor is open for nominations for Council President and Vice President. **Dalldorf moved and Hoppe seconded nominating Iedema President. Iedema moved and Hoppe seconded nominating Spoelstra President. A straw poll was taken, resulting in a tie, with 2 votes for each candidate. Foxley broke the tie by voting for Spoelstra to be President.**

**Spoelstra moved and Iedema seconded nominating Foxley Vice President. Dalldorf moved and Hoppe seconded nominating Iedema Vice President. A straw poll was taken, resulting in a tie, with 2 votes for each candidate. Foxley broke the tie by voting for Iedema to be Vice President.**

**SIGNATURE CARDS. Hoppe moved and Dalldorf seconded authorizing Mayor Gustad, Council President Spoelstra, Council Vice President Iedema, and Finance Officer Westerhuis to sign new signature cards at the banks. Motion passed on voice vote.**

**SOUTHERN MISSOURI RECYCLING & WASTE MANAGEMENT DELEGATE. Mayor Gustad appointed Jerry Overweg as the city's representative on the Southern Missouri Recycling & Waste Management District Board. Iedema moved and Dalldorf seconded approving Mayor Gustad's appointment. Motion passed on voice vote.**

**EXECUTIVE SESSION – PERSONNEL MATTERS. Dalldorf moved and Spoelstra seconded entering into executive session at 9:00 p.m. for discussion of personnel matters. President Foxley declared an end to executive session at 9:12 p.m. Hoppe moved and Spoelstra seconded allowing Travis Dyk until the end of 2009 to obtain one of the three required water/wastewater certifications. Motion passed on voice vote.**

**COUNCIL COMMENTS. There being no further business before the City Council, Spoelstra moved and Hoppe seconded to adjourn the meeting at 9:13 p.m. Motion passed on voice vote.**
