

CHAPTER 10-2 SIDEWALKS

10-2-1 GRADES & CURB LINES

Grades and curb lines as heretofore established by the City as shown on map prepared by the City Engineer and now on file in the office of the City Finance Officer are hereby adopted as the official grades and curb lines of the City and all sidewalks hereafter constructed shall be in accordance with such map.

10-2-2 SUPERVISION OF SIDEWALK & CURBING CONSTRUCTION

The building and construction of all sidewalks and curbing within the limits of the streets and alleys of the City shall be done under direct supervision of the City and its duly appointed officers and agents, and all such sidewalks shall be constructed on the grades as determined by the said City.

10-2-3 SPECIFICATIONS

The construction of all sidewalks and curbing whether to be done by direct contract with the City or by contract with the abutting property owners shall be done strictly in accordance with the Council and on file in the office of the City Finance Officer. The Council shall have full power to condemn work and material not in accordance with the requirements of said specifications.

10-2-4 PERMIT REQUIRED

Before any sidewalk or curbing is constructed within the limits of the streets and alleys in the City by any contractor or person for the owner or owners of abutting property, said contractor or person must first secure a permit from the City Finance Officer.

10-2-5 WIDTH OF SIDEWALKS

Except as otherwise provided, all sidewalks on all side streets shall not be less than four (4) or more than eight (8) feet in width and shall conform to the width, grade and curb lines of the adjoining sidewalks.
